## BUILDING, FACILITY, AND ROOM DESIGNATIONS

### CHANGES

1. **6 FAM 1792, Building Designations:** The National Foreign Affairs Training Center (NFATC) was renamed the George P. Shultz National Foreign Affairs Training Center by Public Law 107-132 (115 Stat. 2412) on January 16, 2002.

2. **Change Transmittal** has replaced the term, Transmittal Letter. Change Transmittal was selected as being more appropriate in this age of electronic information transmission. The FAM volume's transmittal acronym and numerical series remains in place.

3. Revisions since the last update appear in italics. Other than formal titles, the italics will be removed the next time the material is updated. Only current changes will appear in italics. Italics provide a historical record of changes.

4. Officers are reminded that Department-issued materials not codified in the *Foreign Affairs Manual* or its supplemental *Foreign Affairs Handbook* series generally have no regulatory validity (see 2 FAM 1115.2).

### FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER COPIES

1. Remove and discard old 6 FAM subchapter 1790 (issued under TL:GS-67, 01-31-2001; 3 pages) and replace it with revised 6 FAM subchapter 1790 (3 pages).

2. After inserting the material in the binder, insert this transmittal letter immediately following the CT (formerly TL) checklist, then fill in the entry line for CT:GS-135, and initial.
