

12 FAH-8 H-550 PHYSICAL SECURITY ENHANCEMENT FUNDING

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

12 FAH-8 H-551 GENERAL

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. The majority of post requests for physical security enhancement funding only require approval and allocation of funds from DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. A small number of requests may require coordination with and funding from other bureaus or agencies. DS/CIS/PSP/FPD has the responsibility for identifying these requests and coordinating the responses to post. Therefore, all residential physical security upgrade requests should be initiated with DS/CIS/PSP/FPD.

b. Construction and/or renovation of perimeter barriers can be an expensive and complicated physical security enhancement. Funding sources for perimeter barriers are covered separately in 12 FAH-8, H-510.

c. Most physical security enhancements may require a greater expenditure of funds for procurement and installation than that required for maintenance and repair. If funded by DS/CIS/PSP/FPD they are accounted for under function codes 5841 (Residential Security Upgrades) and 5843 (Residential Security Maintenance and Repair). 12 FAH-8 H-552 GOVERNMENT-OWNED (GO) PROPERTY

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

For U.S. Government-owned property, residential security funding (depending on the specific details of the security enhancement/upgrade) may need to be approved and/or provided by DS/CIS/PSP/FPD or M/OBO/OM/AM. Posts should send their initial residential security funding request with justifications and cost estimates to DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. DS/CIS/PSP/FPD will coordinate funding responsibility with other bureaus as required.

12 FAH-8 H-553 LONG-TERM LEASED (LTL) PROPERTY

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

Every effort should be made to have physical residential security enhancements funded by the property owner. For long-term lease property where the owner refuses to make the required improvements, residential security funding (depending on the specific details of the security enhancement/upgrade) may need to be approved and/or provided by DS/CIS/PSP/FPD or M/OBO/OM/AM. Posts should send their initial residential security funding request with justifications and cost estimates to DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. DS/CIS/PSP/FPD will coordinate funding responsibility with other bureaus as required.

12 FAH-8 H-554 SHORT-TERM LEASED (STL) PROPERTY

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

For short-term leased residences every effort should be made to have residential security enhancements funded by the owner or landlord. For short-term leased property where the owner refuses to make the required improvements funding should be requested from DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. Complete information including, reason for the enhancement and its installation costs must be provided as part of the funding request.
