12 FAH-8 H-631 GENERAL

a. Outdoor lighting used as a security enhancement can be a major deterrent against criminal intrusion. When properly used, it can discourage criminal activity and aid observation. Lighting, used as a security enhancement, should be focused on areas of the property such as entrances and areas adjacent to building facades. DS/CIS/PSP/FPD will fund requests for this kind of lighting. See 12 FAH-6, *Security Standards*, for details on illumination requirements.

b. Funding for outdoor lighting used for aesthetic purposes or other reasons will **not** be provided by DS/CIS/PSP/FPD. This funding is the responsibility of the post or the agency requesting the illumination.

12 FAH-8 H-632 TYPES OF ILLUMINATION

(TL:RSP-01; 11-01-2001)

a. A variety of factors will dictate the type and wattage of lighting to be used. These factors include:

- (1) The type of residence;
- (2) The amount of masking by trees and shrubbery; and
- (3) Other security lighting throughout the neighborhood and/or area.

b. The RSO and/or PSO should make the final determination for any additional security lighting.
