1. BEGIN SUMMARY: ON SECOND DAY OF PARLYAMENTARY DEBATE RELATED TO MURPHY'S STATEMENT REPORTED REFTELL MAIN ATTENTION WAS GIVEN TO REASONS FOR ATTORNEY GENERAL'S "PAID" ON XSIO OFFICES IN MELBOURNE. IN HIS ANSWERS MARCH 27, MURPHY SAID HE HAD "RAIDED" MELPOURNE HEADQUARTERS OF ASIO MARCH 16 BECAUSE HE HAD DISCOVERED COPY OF DOCUMENT IN VISIT TO ASID HEADQUARTERS. IN CANBERRA NIGHT BEFORE AROUT WHICH HE HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY BEEN INFORMED. QUESTIONS WERE ASKED ABOUT DOCUMENT WHICH MURPHY STATED HE COULD NOT DISCUSS BECAUSE OF SECURITY IMPLICATIONS . NEXT QUESTION WAS WHY HE "VISITED" ASID OFFICES IN CANBERRA, TO WHICH MURPHY GAVE NO RESPONSE. IN COURSE OF OTHER QUESTIONING IN PARLIAMENT. PRIME MINISTER WHITLAM REPORTEDLY EVADED QUESTION ABOUT MELBOURNE "RAID" AND WAS "CALCULATEDLY ARROGANT" IN HIS! MANNER WHEN REFUSING TO ANSWER. END SUMMARY

ATTORNERY GENERAL MURPHY SAID HE "VISITED" MELBOURNE' HEADQUARTERS OF ASID MORNING OF MARCH 16 AFTER HAVING DISCOVERED COPY OF DECUMENT CONTAINED IN ASIO'S CANBERRA FILES DURING VISIT NIGHT BEFORE. FILE CONTAINING ORIGINAL DOCUMENT HAS SINCE BEEN BROUGHT TO CANBERRA. WHEN ASKED WHY HE "VISITED" ASIO HEADQUARTERS: IN EANBERRA MARCH 15, MURPHY GAVE NO DIRECT RESPONSE. HE DID STATE, HOWEVER, THAT DOCUMENT HAD SOME DIRECT RELATIONSHIP TO VISIT OF YUGOSLAV PRIME MINISTER BIJEDIC AND ALSO CONCERNED MEMBERS OF THE FEDERAL MINISTRY, INCLUDING HIMSELF AND PRIME MINISTER WHILLAM. MURPHY DECLINED TO DISCUSS OR MAKE PUBLIC CONTENTS OF THE DOCUMENT ON THE RASIS THAT TO DO SO WOULD "INJURE NATIONAL SECURITY".
