THE RISE IN TERRORIST ACTIVITIES, COMMENCING WITH FORMOSA ATTACK (REFTEL A) BROUGHT HINTS YESTERDAY FROM JUSTICE MINISTER ERNESTO CORVALAN NANCLARES THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE OF SIEGE WILL BE BROADENED IN SCOPE. END SUMMARY.
- 2. FIVE FEDERAL POLICEMEN WERE KILLED IN A BUENOS AIRES SUB-URB SUNDAY MORNING (OCT. 26). THE FIVE WERE ATTACKED WHILE PASSING BY THE SAN ISIDRO CATHEDRAL IN TWO PATROL CARS. FOUR OTHER SECURITY AND MILITARY PERSONNEL WERE ALSO REPORTED KILLED IN CLASHES WITH SUBVERSIVES IN VARIOUS PARTS OF ARGEN-TINA DURING PAST FEW DAYS. ASSISTANT FEDERAL POLICE CHIEF HORACIO ALBERTO ROJAS WAS ALSO ATTACKED BY A GUERILLA FORCE LATE THURSDAY NIGHT (OCT. 25), ACCORDING NEWS ACCOUNTS.
