
Dear Senator Specter:

It has come to my attention that the local chapter of Amnesty International is mounting an effort to determine the whereabouts of a Penn State math professor who disappeared in Chile in 1984. The group is concerned that Professor Boris Weisfeiler, who disappeared in Chile in December 1984, may have been the victim of foul play, political or otherwise.

I would appreciate your good offices in supporting efforts to resolve the questions surrounding the disappearance of Professor Weisfeiler. Should you have questions, I would urge you to contact David Tubbs, a Penn State student who has led the establishment of Amnesty International in this university community. Mr. Tubbs also was a Penn State nominee for Rhodes Scholar this year.
