LISA BISHOP, DPOB 4/11/65, NORTH CAROLINA, HAS BEEN MISSING SINCE DECEMBER, 1988, WHEN SHE BOARDED THE 82 FOOT BAHAMIAN REGISTERED SAILING VESSEL "FREEDON" (OR "FREEDOM"), WHICH WAS FOUND FROM MIAMI TO HAITI WITH A LOAD OF USED BICYCLES, CARS AND CLOTHING. NEITHER THE SHIP NOR ANY OF THE PEOPLE ABOARD, INCLUDING LISA BISHOP AND THE GERMAN CAPTAIN, FLORIAN MEYER-BORCHERT, HAVE BEEN HEARD FROM SINCE.
2. MEYER-BORCHERT'S FAMILY IN GERMANY HAVE GIVEN HIM UP FOR DEAD, BUT LISA'S FAMILY AND HER EX-BOYFRIEND, PAUL CORNWELLS, CONTINUE TO ADVISE THE DEPARTMENT OF "SIGHTINGS" OF THE BOAT IN VARIOUS CARIBBEAN PORTS. INFO

Dear Mr. Fowler:

Thank you for your recent inquiry written on behalf of your constituent Mrs. Linda Bishop concerning the 1988 disappearance of her daughter, Lisa Lynn Bishop.

The U.S. Embassy in Port au Prince has searched its records of repatriated Haitians for the names of the crew members who were traveling with Lisa Bishop. Unfortunately, they found no match. They have also asked U.S. Immigration in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, to check INS files of Haitians screened into the United States for any leads. We will advise you of any new development.

In the more than three years since Lisa Bishop's disappearance, the U.S. missions in Port au Prince, Belize, Havana, Kingston, Nassau and Frankfurt have been involved in the search to locate any leads to her possible whereabouts or those of the ship "Freedom" and her crew. The State Department and its officers abroad remain ready to assist Mrs. Bishop. You may also wish to contact the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service and the U.S. Coast Guard on behalf of your constituent to see if they might have any information not available to the State Department.



In response to our conversation on May 26th, 1992; I am forwarding you a formal request concerning the disappearance of Lisa Lynn Bishop in December, 1988.

I request that the following list of Haitian Seamen be cross-referenced with the INS list of Haitian detainees processed by the US Coast Guard over the last two years. I would also ask that the list of boats detained over that same period be compared with the description of The "Freedom," also reported missing since Dec. 1988.


These men would be material witnesses to an act of piracy and kidnapping of an American citizen. The boat has been sighted numerous times in the Caribbean Sea. The FBI case is #2670272QD and the agent in charge is Mike Clark at (912) 226-0626.

Several attempts have been made to acquire this information, through the State Dept., INS, FBI, DEA, and the Offices of Congressmen Gingrich and Lewis, to no avail.

There is a good chance if these men are alive, they would have attempted entry into the US. There has been recent unconfirmed information that Lisa along with numerous other Americans, are being held in Cuba by the drug cartels and by other persons unknown.

To this date, I have received only a minimal assist by any branch of the US Government. I cannot believe that if there is any truth to this at all, your office would not want a full investigation. I have enclosed pertinent information and descriptions. Please feel free to call me with any questions you may have at (404) 523-3712. Thank you for your concern and assistance.





According to our records, last November 12th, 1989, at 18:00 hours a Bahamian registered boat named "Freedom" entered the Moa port, Holguin Province, with seven crewmembers on board, including five Haitians, one West German and one Belgium from the Miami port, from where it had sailed out on November 11th, 1989, at 20:00 hours heading for Haiti.

This boat was intercepted by a surface unit of the Coast Guard Troops of the Republic of Cuba, and brought to the above port after it had penetrated into Cuban waters.

The characteristics of this boat are as follows:

- . Length : 82 feet
- . Beam : 18 feet
- . Depth of hold : 8 feet
- . Drive : 200 HP Volvo engine
- . Construction : Steel

On December 19, 1988 the "Freedon" left Port of Miami with a crew of 12, bound for Gonaive, Haiti. The "Freedon" was an 82 foot steel cargo trawler of 'whaleback-wheelhouse' at stern, two deck level design, with open forward deck and forward cargo mast (possibly bent to starboard or now removed). The vessel was last seen in a rusty hull condition and white wheelhouse.

The "Freedon"(or "Freedom") was supposedly lost at sea on 12-26-88, however this may not be true. The ship's master, described on attached, has been sighted over 50 times, and reportedly in your area, since date of assumed sinking. The intent of this search is to locate "David Florian" and a member of the crew "Lisa Lynn Bishop."

David Florian is the principal in the search, due to prior sightings. He is German, although has little accent. He enjoys bands, nightclubs, rock/raggae music, girls, and boats. He plays bass guitar and keyboards. He uses drugs, including pot and cocaine. He may be involved in drug smuggling. He could be crewing or master of a sailboat or powerboat. He might be in the company of another European or group of same. He will appear to be somewhat vain about his looks, yet unkept because it would fit in the social scheme of where he might appear. He should be considered dangerous. Should you make contact, take no action on your own, a response team will be at your sighting within hours.

David Florian can appear to be rather childish for his age, especially in the company of others while drinking or on drugs, yet he is quite intelligent and resourceful.

It can only be said that 11 people are missing, under his care as ship's master, including Lisa Bishop (where this investigation hopes to end).

Your call, should you know anything of the whereabouts of David Florian, will be treated with the utmost confidentiality. A reward is offered to assist in his locating. You will not be involved in any actions against David.
