Wednesday is Pakistan and Blackwater.

Thursday is Russia and Canada.

Friday is Afghan Corruption and Karzai (two separate stories!).

Saturday is Yemen

Sunday is China

Monday is Terrorist Financing and possibly something on Iraq for which you have no cables yet Tuesday is Arms Trade (Weapons) and possibly something on NATO for which you have no cables yet

So I hope we can have a talk tomorrow about Pakistan and Blackwater at the very least; it would be great to get farther through the stack.

Glad to talk about any other concerns. Who knows what they'll do in the future, but you may have noticed that contrary to the White House statement expecting "several hundred thousand" cables to be released Sunday night by WikiLeaks,
