

**The Secretary's Call Sheet for  
Transitional National Council Chairman Abdel Jalil**

**Purpose of call: To express American support and solidarity with Jalil and the TNC on the historic events unfolding in Libya and to encourage him to use his leadership to support a peaceful, transparent, and inclusive transition to democracy.**

**Background: TNC Chairman Abdel Jalil is the widely respected and mild-mannered leader of the Transitional National Council, considered the "anti-Qadhafi." He announced the arrest of Qadhafi's son, Saif al-Islami, by rebel forces August 21 and is reportedly preparing now for an address to the Libyan people on the end of Qadhafi's reign. While the TNC**

has said they are committed to avoiding bloodshed and retributive violence, it is important now that Abdel Jalil make a national appeal to Libyans to do so. You sent him a letter encouraging the consolidation of control over the militias and a credible investigation of General Younis' killing, which was hand-delivered by Assistant Secretary Feltman August 20.
